Per our Bylaws:

“When there is one or more direct elect vacancy on the Board, the existing or remaining Board shall notify the RSC in writing of the number of direct elect Board of Director seats which have become vacant and which will become vacant by the next annual meeting of the Board by virtue of expiration of the term of office for certain outgoing Directors. Such notification shall occur not less than sixty (60) calendar days prior to the date of the election which will fill such vacancies and 120 calendar days prior to the date of any meeting of the Board at which any direct elect seat is expiring.”
