“The Board of Directors shall cause an annual report to be furnished not later than 120 days after the close of the Corporation’s fiscal year.” (CCCE Inc NP Bylaws Amend 031323, Page 14, Section 3)

Copies of the Annual Report will be distributed at RSC and have been uploaded to Google Groups along with this document.

“When there is one or more pool seat vacancy on the Board, the existing or remaining Board shall notify the RSC in writing of the number of Board of Director seats which have become vacant and which will become vacant by the next annual meeting of the Board by virtue of expiration of the term of office for certain outgoing Directors. Such notification shall occur not less than sixty (60) calendar days prior to the date of the election which will fill such vacancies and 120 calendar days prior to the date of any meeting of the Board at which any pool seat is expiring.” (CCCE Inc NP Bylaws Amend 031323, Page 4, Section 8 (b) 1.)

This is that notification. We have one open and two that are expiring “Pool Elect” Directorship(s) of the Corporation to be filled at our Annual Meeting, March 14, 2026.
